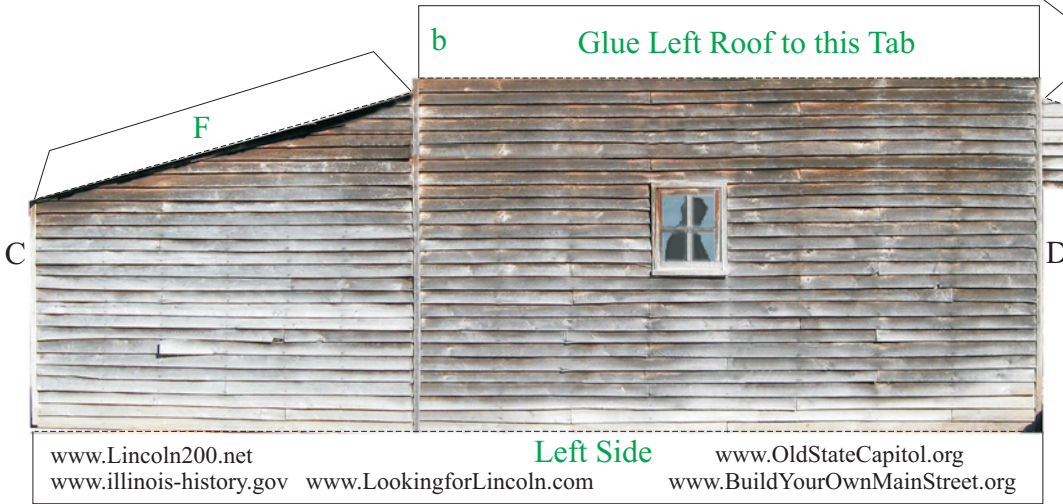
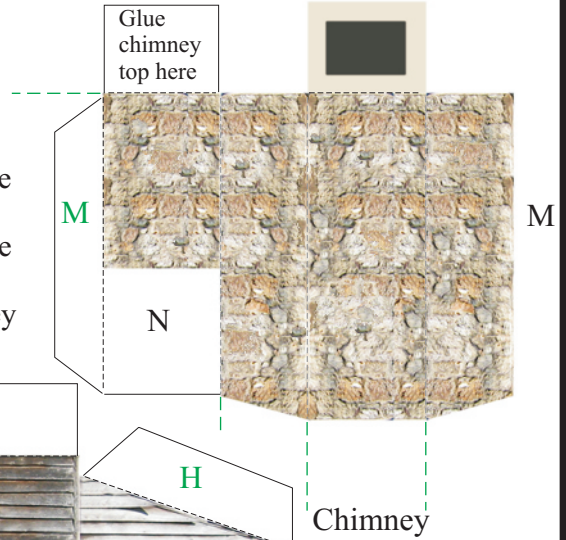


Basic Directions:

1. Lightly score dotted lines before cutting piece out to make folding easier.
2. Be careful to cut around all tabs.
3. Dotted lines are to be folded. Green dotted lines and green letters should be folded backward. Red dotted lines and red letters should be folded forward. Letters indicate how pieces should fit together.

To Assemble Walls, Roofs and Chimney:

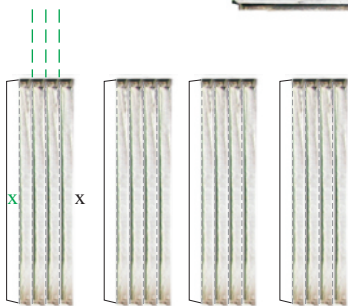
1. Cut out the Front, Back and Side pieces. Fold all dotted lines.
2. Glue the Front onto the Left and Right Sides using tabs A and D.
3. Glue the Back onto the sides using tabs B and C.
4. Glue the corners of all bottom tabs to create a base.
5. Cut out the Roof and Chimney pieces. Fold all dotted lines.
6. Glue the Back Roof to side tabs E and F. With the Back Gable vertical, glue it to the main side tabs at the corners marked a and b.
7. Glue the Porch Roof to the Sides using tabs G and H.
8. Glue the Right Roof onto the Front and Back using tabs I and J and onto the Right Side tab. Glue the top tab at letters c and d to create a ridge.
9. Glue the Left Roof onto the Front and Back using tabs K and L and onto the Left Side tab. It will project about 1/16" at the top.
10. Glue Chimney tab M to create a tube of rectangular section. Glue chimney top to the blank tab. Glue the Chimney to the back Gable Wall at N.



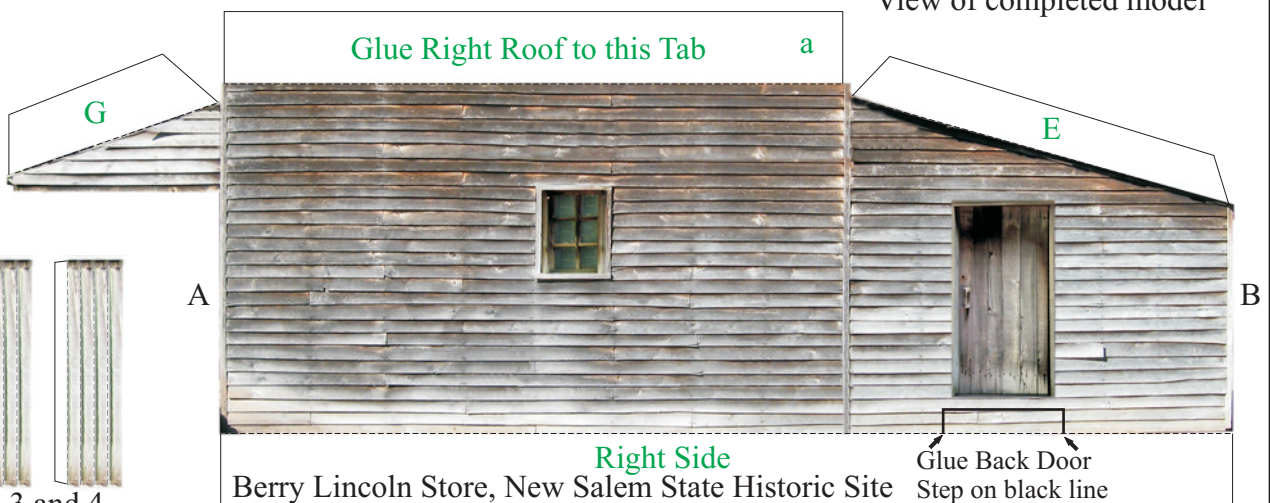
View of completed model

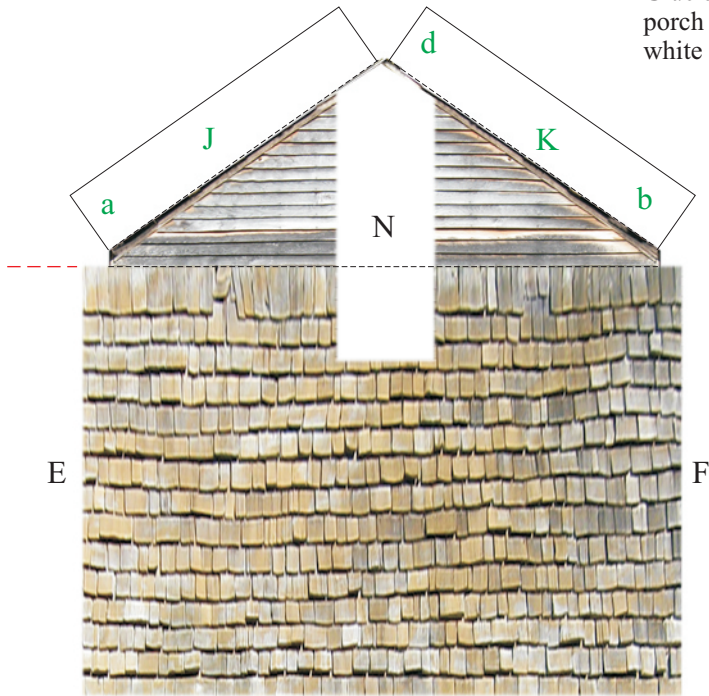
To Add Front Porch, Posts and Back Step:

1. Cut out the Porch, Posts, and Step pieces. Fold all dotted lines.
2. Glue the Front Porch tabs as indicated by letters O, P, Q, and R to create a raised platform. Glue Porch to Front Wall at e and f.
3. Glue the tab on Post 1 to create a tube of square cross section. Repeat for Posts 2, 3, and 4.
4. Glue the Four Posts to the porch floor at the white squares and to the underside of the Porch Roof so they are vertical.
5. Glue the Back Door Step to the Right Side at the black line marked below the door.

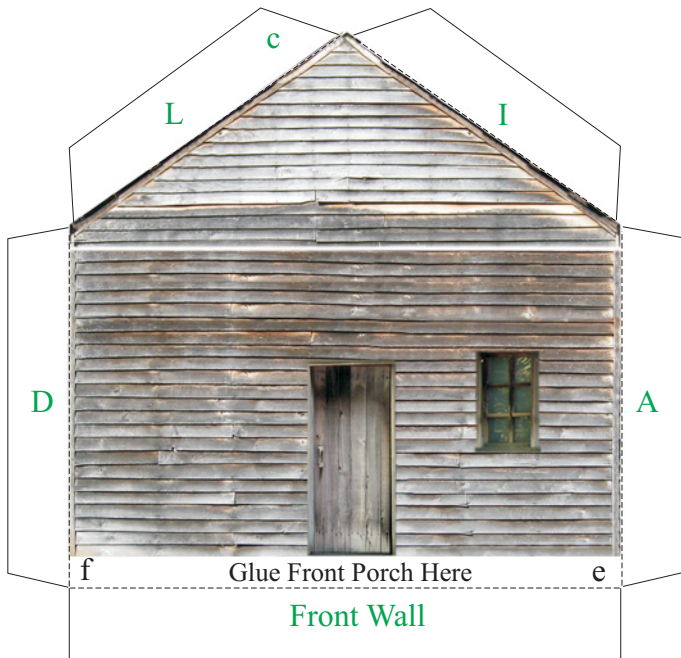
